

**HOW TO EXHIBIT** 

(Sections 11 to 25 inclusive)

1. Complete the entry form (in back of schedule) and post with entry fee to Beenleigh Show Society, Post Office Box 66, Beenleigh, Qld 4207

Or Email Entry form to reception@beenleighshow.com.au and pay entry fees into Westpac BSB 034605 Account No 000041 using the first three letters of your surname and Section No as your reference.

All completed forms must be received by 5 pm on FRIDAY 2nd September 2022.

Additional entry forms are available from the Secretary or may be photocopied.

- Exhibits will be received by the Stewards from 7.30 a.m. to 12 noon on FRIDAY September 09th 2022. Please take exhibits to the Pavilion. Tickets must be attached by sellotape or pin to the articles before handing to the Stewards.
- 3. Exhibits will be judged from 1.00 pm FRIDAY September 09th, 2022.
- 4. Exhibits must be collected on SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 11th, 2022 between 10 am and 11 am. No exhibits may be removed before 10 am. Stewards are not responsible for exhibits after 11 am on Sunday September 11th, 2022.
- 5. **DISPLAY/HANGING OF EXHIBITS:** Not all exhibits may be displayed or hung.
- 6. **PRIZES.** First \$10.00 Second \$5.00 unless otherwise stated. Where a trophy is allocated, there is no cash First Prize.
- 7. ENTRY FEES: \$2.00 unless otherwise stated.
- 8. An Exhibitor whose Entry Fees are \$50 or over will receive a *FREE PASS* to the 2022 Annual Show.
- 9. Late Entries will only be accepted in Section 13 (Cut Flowers)
- 10. Points for Sections 11 to 24 inclusive will be : first three points : second one point. In the event of a tie for Most Successful Exhibitor, the Trophy will be awarded to the person awarded the most First prizes.
- 11. To collect exhibits, Entry Docket must be presented to the Stewards. No one is to remove their exhibits from the display, as this is the responsibility of the Stewards.
- 12. Prize money and trophies may be collected between 10 am and 11 am on Sunday from the Secretary's Office.

Board size to be 3 cm larger than exhibit ALL ROUND Biscuits to be exhibited in clear lidded bottles.

No packet mixes to be used unless specified.

#### RULES FOR RICH DARK FRUIT CAKE COMPETITION. (Class 12)

- Own recipe maybe used.
- To be half-pound (250g) mixture with approx. 1.15kg of fruit to be used, including currants (whole), sultanas and raisins (cut), mixed peel (cherries and nuts optional)
- To be baked in a SQUARE tin.
- The winner at the BEENLEIGH SHOW will be eligible to enter in the Sub-chamber final to be held at Beenleigh next year. The winner of the Sub-chamber final will be required to enter at the Royal Qld Show in Brisbane in August next year. One pound mixture baked in a 27cm (10") square tin will apply for this competition.

- Beetroot cake, baked in round tin, with chocolate icing.

- Butterfly cakes (5) without papers.
   Carrot Cake, uniced.

- 21. Pikelets, 5, not less than 5 cm across
- 22. Plum Pudding boiled in cloth
- 23. Plum Pudding Steamed
- Presentation Afternoon Tea Plate (not disposable) of an assortment of five (5) different varieties of any of the following small cakes, biscuits, slices, pastries etc. Minimum of 2 of each variety.
- 25. Scones, plain 5, not less than 5 cm across

- 26. Scones, any other variety, 5, not less than 5 cm across
- 27. Slice, biscuit base, any filling, 5 pieces (Base plus 2 layers filling)
- 28. Slice, 3 varieties, 2 each variety approximately 5 cm (2 inch) square
- 29. Shortbread, one round cut into 8 wedge shaped pieces
- Sponge Roll
- 31. Sponge Sandwich, joined with fine line of white icing, top dusted with icing sugar
- Sugarcraft
- 33. Sultana Cake, round or square
